PARENT VIEWING SESSIONS

Parents are NOT permitted to observe classes. While the presence of a parent will often relax an individual child, other students may be distracted or uncomfortable with an audience.

Instructors will host **scheduled viewing sessions** throughout the season. Parents are invited to sit in and view their child's classes during the following dates:

HOLIDAYS & CLOSURES

The studio is CLOSED on the dates listed below. Your flat-rate monthly fee takes all holiday closures into account – your overall fee is cheaper because we removed all closure days from the calculation. In other words, you are not charged for them.

Spring Break, Mon, Mar 19th – Sun, Mar 27th (Classes resume Mon Mar, 28th)

Easter Break, Fri, April 22nd – Mon, April 25th (Classes resume Tues, April 26th)

Victoria Day Weekend, Sat, May 21st– Mon, May 23rd (Classes resume Tues, May 24th)

Year End Recital, STUDIO CLOSES, Sat, June 11th (No classes Sat, June 11th)

FEES & PAYMENT

Our standard method of billing is **Pre-Authorized Debiting**. Following the completion of a PAD Agreement, the account of your choice is automatically debited on the 1st of each month for a flat-rate fee calculated during registration. The billing process is automated, and occurs each month until end of the season.

Some points of interest regarding registration and class fees:

- **There will be no refunds or compensation for missed classes.**
- **Processed cheques / deposits are non-refundable.**

COMMUNICATION

- EMAIL is our main method of communication; all newsletters, reminders and major announcements are delivered via a studio mailing list.
- Dance parents must remain aware of studio activities; it is their responsibility to do so. Please direct questions to excaliburarts@shaw.ca or call 564-6326.

If one cannot supply a valid email address during registration, please visit the bulletin boards and whiteboards in the lobby and office on a regular basis so as to remain up-to-date on all studio announcements and activities. Studio newsletters, and all updated information will be available on our website (www.excaliburarts.com). Communication is the key to a successful studio, so please do not hesitate to contact us with questions and concerns.

FOOTWEAR PURCHASE POLICY & DANCE ATTIRE

- **Appropriate dance footwear must be ordered within one month of registration.** Proper footwear is very important, not only for purposes of technique, but also for safety!
- Each dance discipline requires different attire. Please speak with your instructor regarding class appropriate clothing and required footwear (available at the *Excalibur Dance Shoppe, located in Building 1*).
- Long hair is to be tied back. All hair must be out of one's face.
- Upon registration, we require a **non-refundable** \$15 registration fee per student.
- Upon registration, we require a **non-refundable** \$30 costume rental fee per student, per class. This fee offsets the cost of a custom-fit, hand made rental costume for the Year End Recital. Students will be measured for size, the fabric will be purchased, the costume will be made, and your child will be fitted (and the costume adjusted, if necessary). Other establishments charge as much as \$50 - \$75 for the same service, and you often have to sew the costume yourself!
- **REGISTRATION AND COSTUME FEES ARE NON- REFUNDABLE UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCE.**
- The initial class fee must be paid *during* registration (cash or cheque).
- **NSF cheques and deposits will incur a \$20 fee additional to the balance owing and result in an immediate discontinuation of service until the issue is resolved.**

CANCELTION / WITHDRAWAL POLICY

Due to the mechanics of our automated billing system, pre-authorized debits are processed several days prior to the actual billing date (the 1st of the month). To ensure we are able to put a stop on payment, **withdrawal requests must be submitted, in writing, NO LATER than the 20th of the month.**

PLEASE REMEMBER: Processed fees are non-refundable.
